


How TO FOCUS



In focusing, always extend tubes too far; then bring them in. Do not rack tubes back and forth — a common mistake. Learn to focus with index finger and thumb while the binocular is held to your eyes. This is the simple, the accurate and the scientific method.

FIRST: Turn focusing knob (B) to extend tubes . . . *using no force*. Cover *right* objective (big lens) with hand, *not touching the glass*. With binocular at eyes, shorten tubes

slowly, until some distant object seen with left eye is perfectly clear and sharp—*then stop instantly*. Cover *left* objective and turn right eyepiece mount (C) left or right until *right* eye sees object clearly.

SECOND: Hold binocular to eyes. Bend sides together or apart until the two circles you see become one. Note setting of scales (A) and (C); thereafter merely set both to same points.

This fine binocular is superior to any imported glass whatsoever, except a few costing about twice as much. With only reasonable care it will give you a lifetime of pleasure.

Like all Wollensak products, it is guaranteed to have its full rated power. Being 8X (8 power) this glass magnifies all distant objects 8 diameters. Each barrel having two glass prisms, this binocular gives a stereoscopic effect never found in an ordinary field glass. The optical system is as fine as we can make it; mechanical parts are

sturdy, proof against dust and moisture. You are going to find this glass the envy of many of your friends.

Proper Care

Keep binocular in case. Don't drop or bump it. Avoid touching or scratching lenses. Clean lenses only when really necessary, *with old linen handkerchief, free from starch*, or eyeglass cleaning cloths, Kleenex—or, better yet, with a soft

camel's hair artist's brush. Moisten only with breath; rub *lightly*; no more than necessary. If repairs should ever be needed send binoculars to *us*, as only a manufacturer can repair a glass properly.

This binocular has been numbered. It will be recorded in your name, as purchaser, for your protection in case of loss or theft, if you return the enclosed blank now.
